The ideal district population, **39,202**, is based on the 2020 Census.
HD 18 has **38,438** people, which is **-1.95%** from the ideal.
59.38% of the people in the district are new constituents.

- 28.45% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.71% of the district is Asian, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 7.21% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.22% of the district is Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 59.98% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 3.63% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 5.02% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

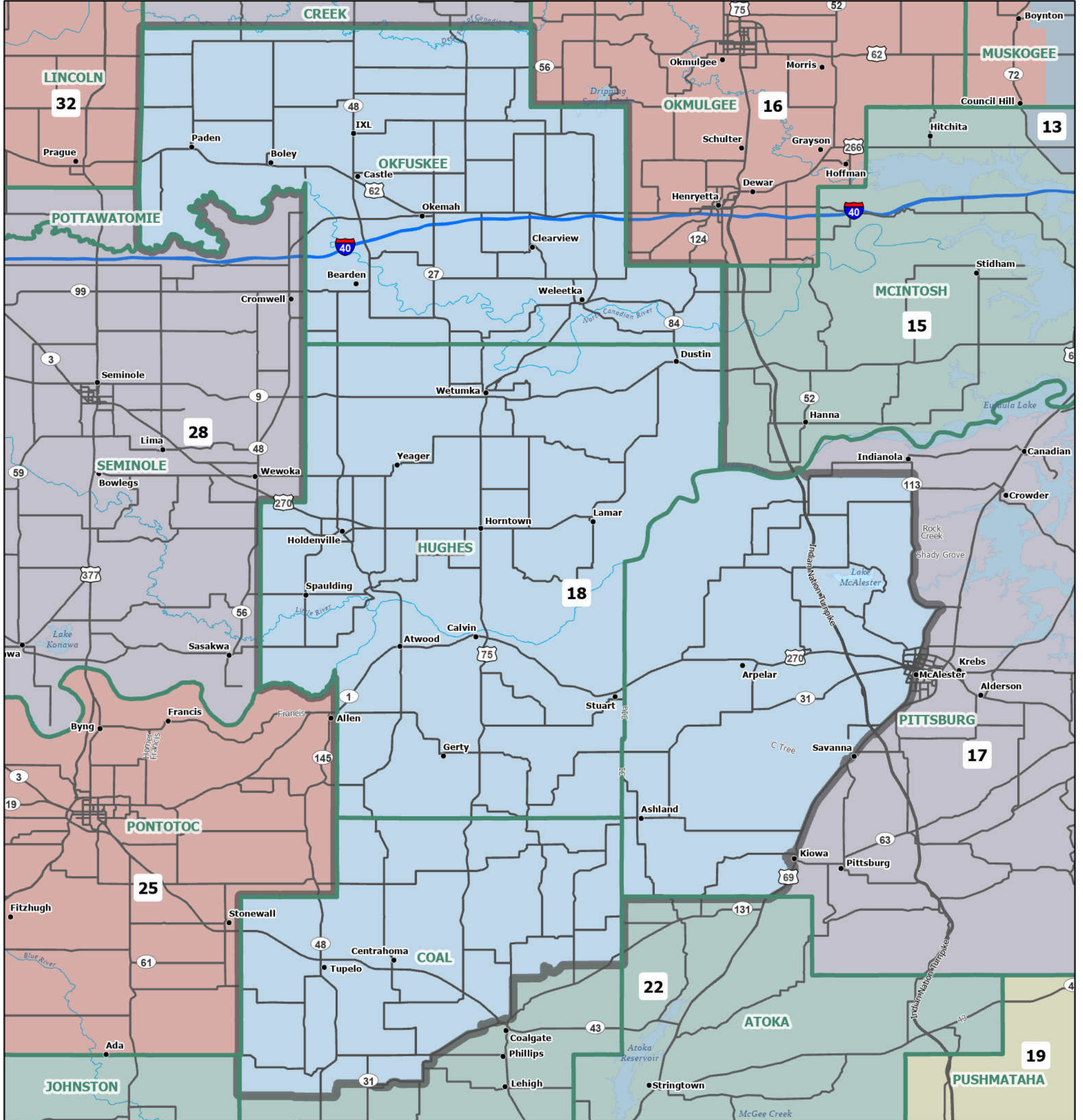

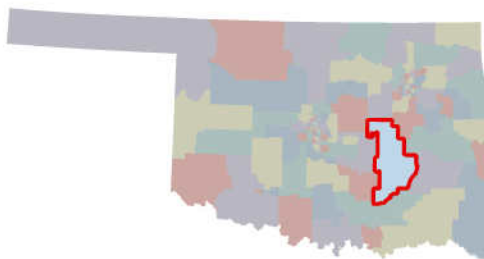
