HD 21 has **38,420** people, which is **-1.99%** from the ideal.

 8.03% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

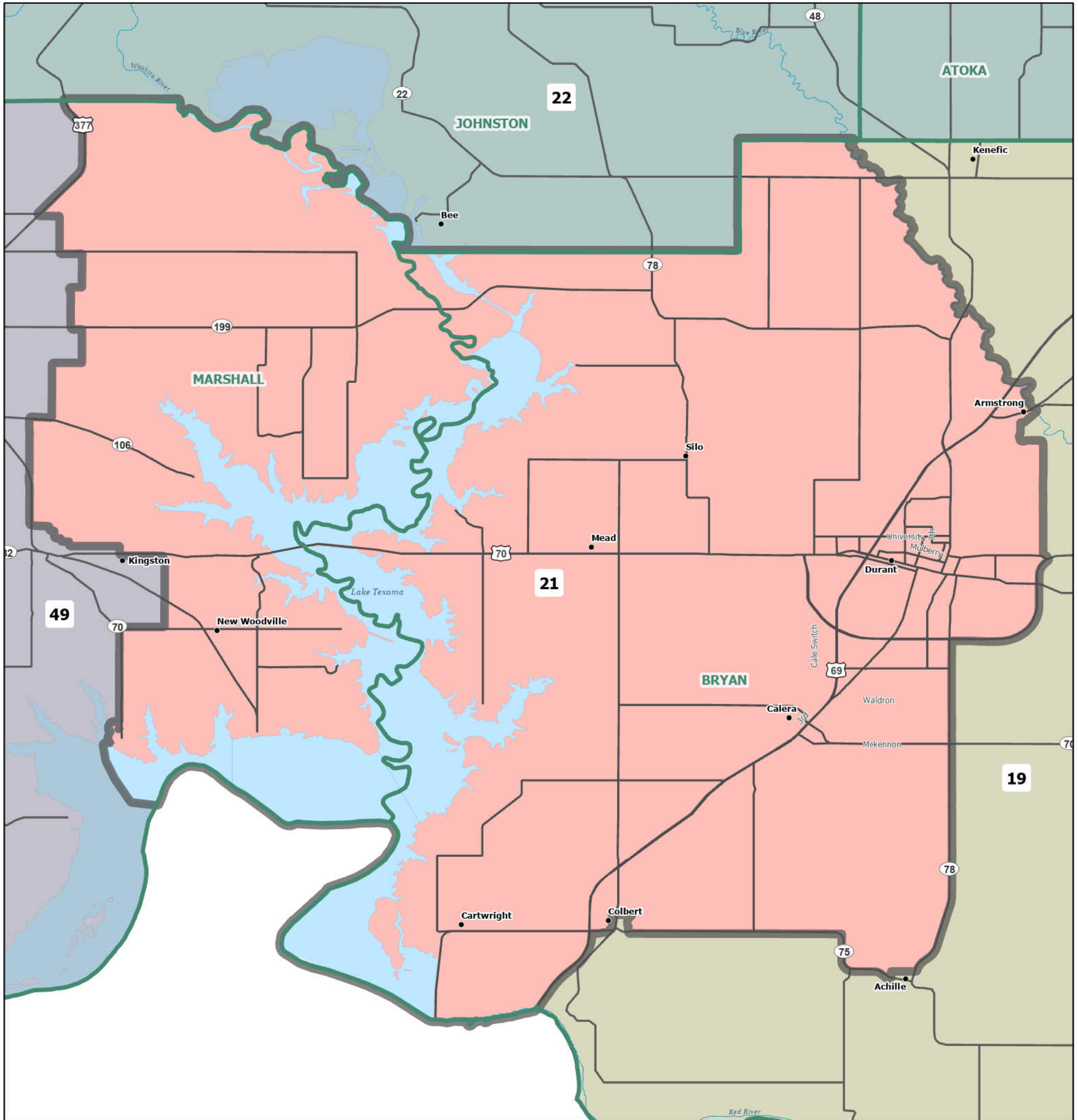

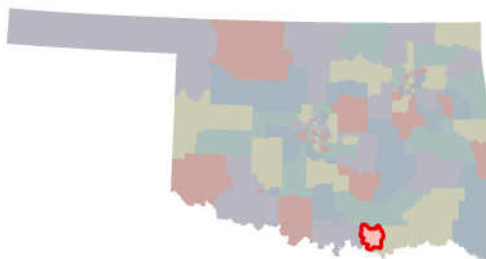
