HD 58 has **39,162** people, which is **-0.1%** from the ideal.
8.75% of the people in the district are new constituents.

- 79.4% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 8.58% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 11.09% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

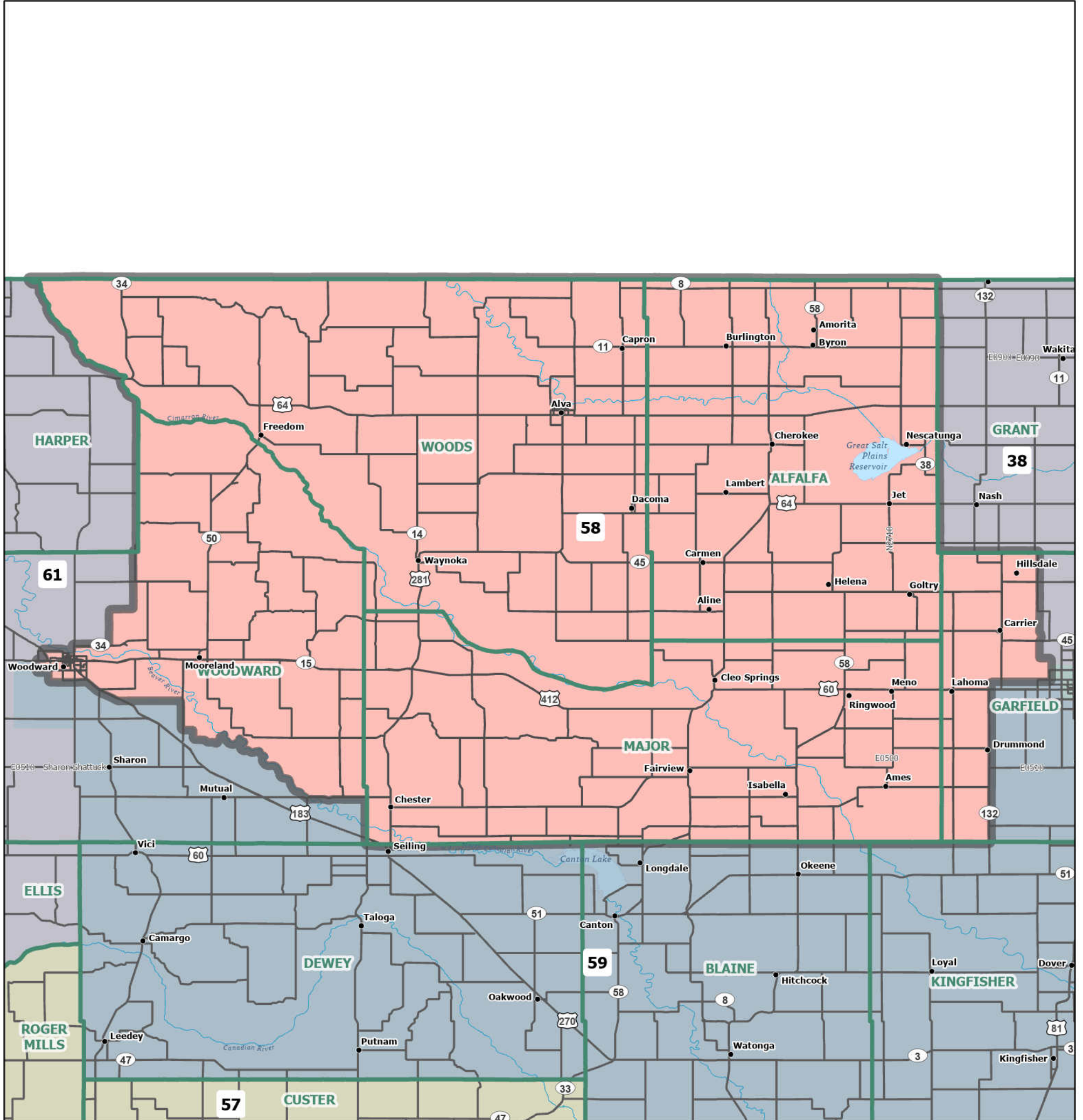

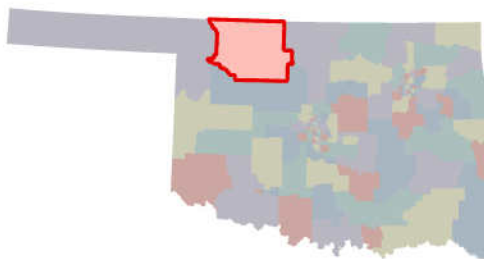
