The ideal district population, **39,202**, is based on the 2020 Census.
HD 61 has **38,526** people, which is **-1.72%** from the ideal.
6.35% of the people in the district are new constituents.

- 5.32% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 1.86% of the district is Asian, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 4.21% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.24% of the district is Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 54.26% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 28.61% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 36.4% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

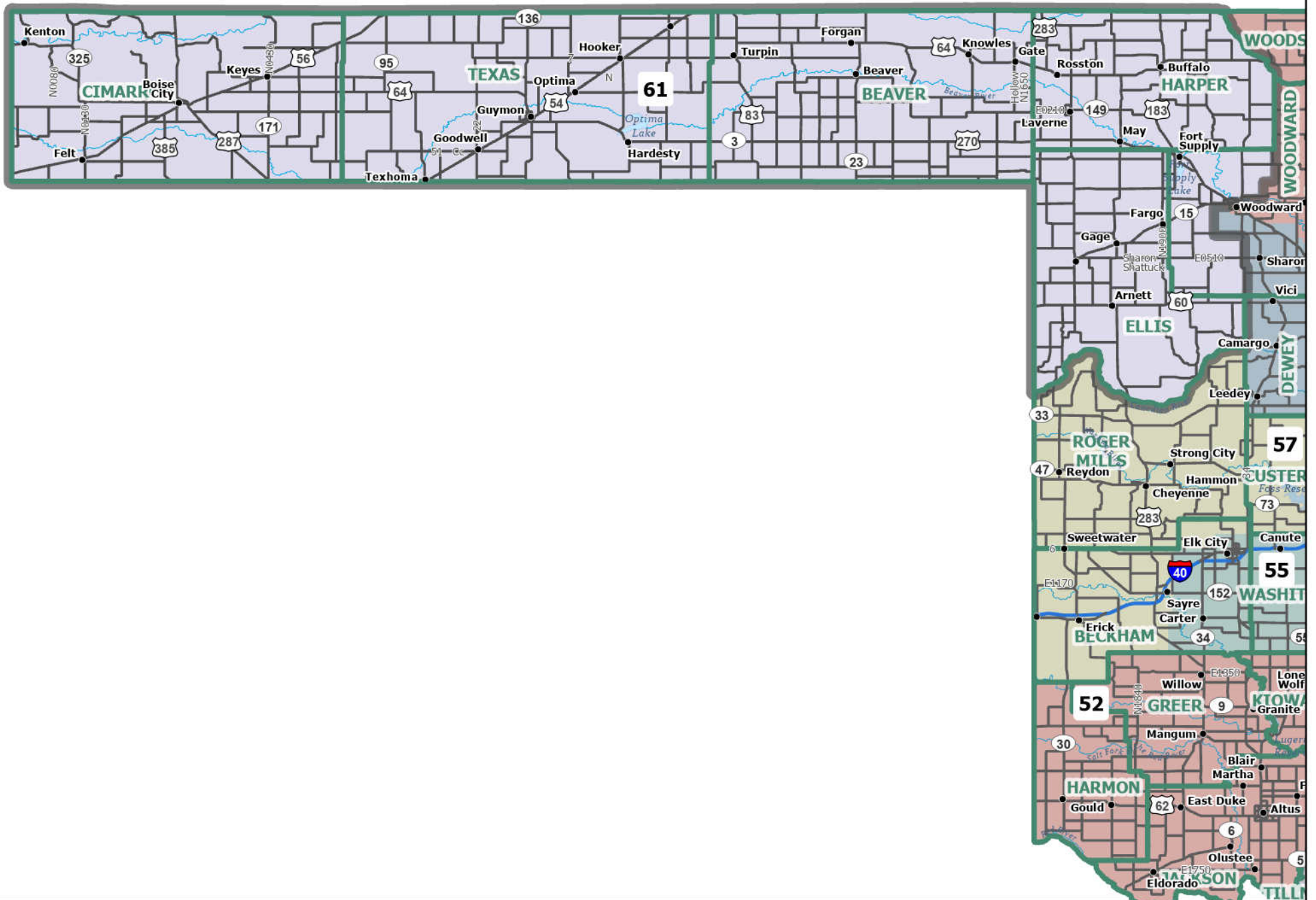

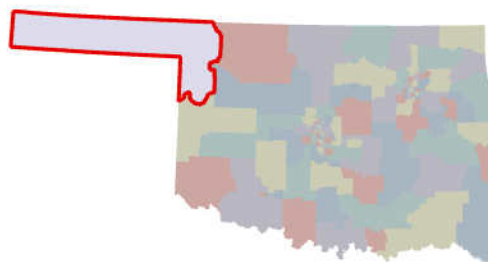
