HD 65 has **39,270** people, which is **0.17%** from the ideal.
45.98% of the people in the district are new constituents.

- 2.05% of the district is Asian, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 7.17% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.59% of the district is Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 59.17% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 6.1% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 10.85% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

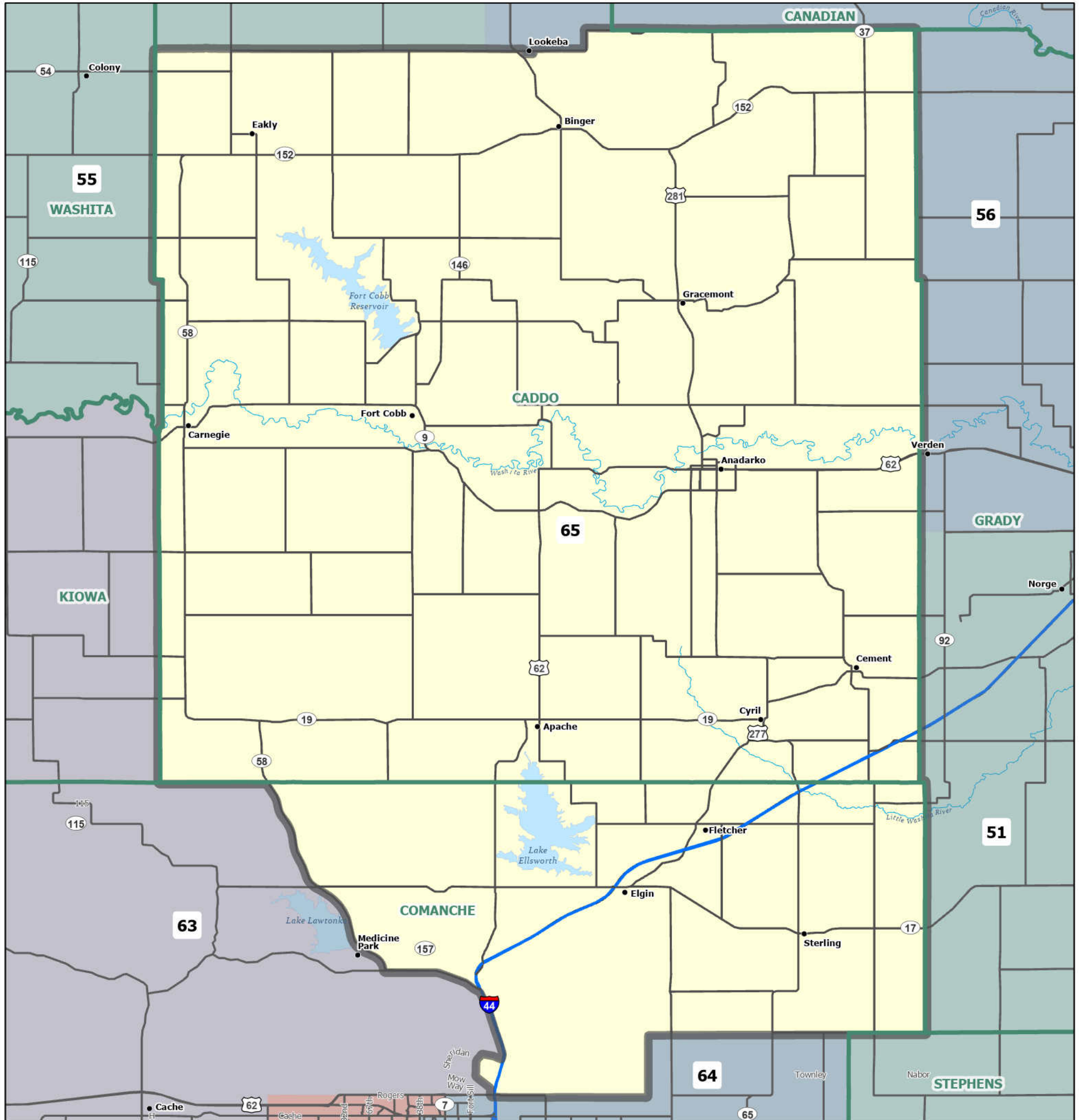

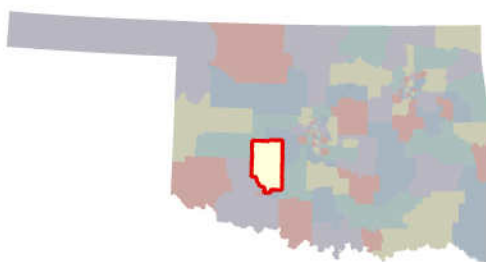
