 8.35% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

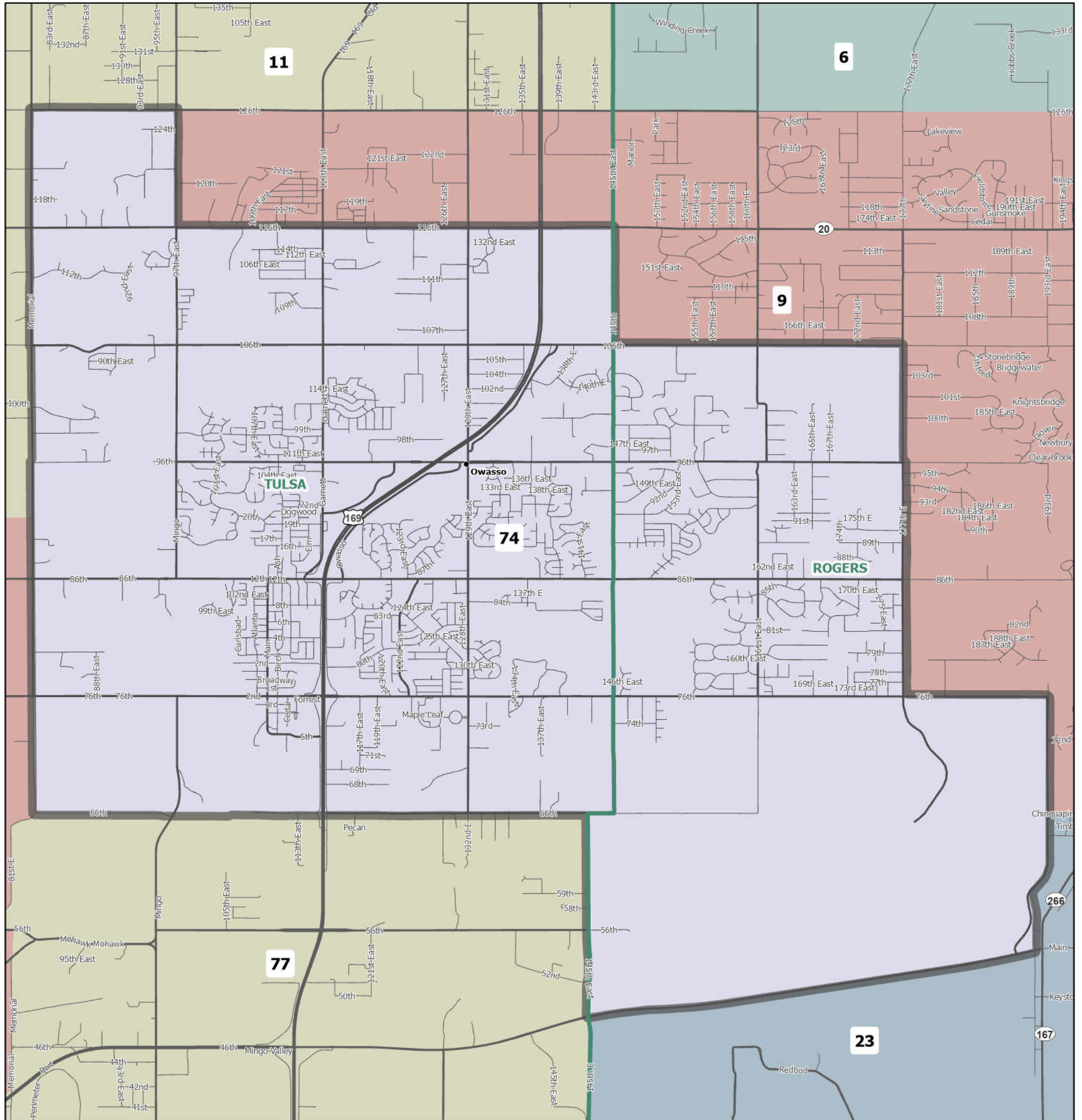

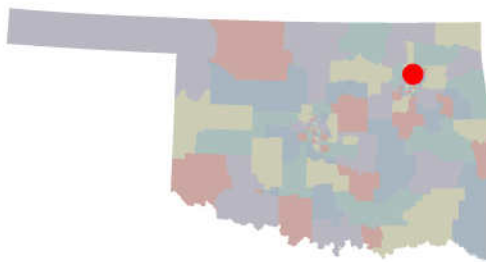
