TOPIC OF THE PROPOSAL:

A study on modernizing the Sales Tax Relief Credit

EXPLANATORY COMMENTS ON THE SCOPE OF THE STUDY PROPOSAL:

The Oklahoma Legislature passed the Sales Tax Relief Credit in 1990 as a way to offset the cost of sales tax for middle and low-income Oklahoma families. Eligibility for the credit was expanded in 1998, but the amount of the credit has remained frozen at \$40.

This study will examine expanding eligibility and modernizing the amount of the credit to ensure fiscal responsibility and greatest benefit to middle and low-income working Oklahomans.
