TOPIC OF THE PROPOSAL:

Examining Medical Marijuana Testing, Transparency, and Public Health Outcomes

EXPLANATORY COMMENTS ON THE SCOPE OF THE STUDY PROPOSAL:

The purpose of this study is to examine Oklahoma's current regulatory framework governing medical marijuana testing, product safety, and consumer transparency. The study will evaluate existing testing standards, compliance requirements, product recall processes, and oversight mechanisms to identify strengths, gaps, and opportunities for improvement within the state's medical marijuana program. The study will review federal Schedule III changes and other states' relevant model legislation and regulations applicable to Oklahoma.

The study will bring together representatives from state agencies, licensed laboratories, dispensaries, industry stakeholders, patient advocates, and subject matter experts to provide testimony, present research, review national and state standards, and discuss challenges affecting patient safety, product consistency, regulatory compliance, and public confidence. The objective is to identify practical policy solutions that enhance transparency, strengthen consumer protections, and support a safe and effective medical marijuana marketplace for Oklahoma patients.
