

# HOUSE JOURNAL

**Third Extraordinary Session of the Fifty-ninth Legislature**

**of the State of Oklahoma**

**Seventeenth Legislative Day, Monday, March 18, 2024**

The House was called to order by Representative Moore.

## **MOTION**

Representative Bashore moved that the attendance roll call of the House in Regular Session be the roll call in the Third Extraordinary Session, which was the order.

The roll was reflected with 82 Members present.

Representative Moore declared a quorum present.

## **MOTION**

Representative Bashore moved that the Journal reflect the motion adopted in Regular Session related to adjourning for more than 3 days, which was the order.

Pursuant to Article V, Section 30 of the Oklahoma Constitution, that the House of Representatives request consent of the Honorable Senate to adjourn the Second Regular Session and the Third Extraordinary Session of the Fifty-ninth Oklahoma Legislature for more than (3) three days, beginning Wednesday, March 20, 2024, and ending Monday, March 25, 2024, which motion was declared adopted.
