MESSAGES FROM THE SENATE

Announcing the passage of **SBs 206, 1465, 1771 and 2110**. The measures were introduced and read for the first time.

SB 206 – By Woods of the Senate and Newton and Hardin of the House.

An Act relating to emergency medical services; amending 63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-2502, which relates to legislative findings and declarations; declaring emergency medical services to be considered essential services for certain purpose; and declaring an emergency.

SB 1465 – By Bergstrom of the Senate and Kendrix of the House.

An Act relating to professions and occupations; amending 59 O.S. 2021, Section 475.3, as last amended by Section 11, Chapter 147, O.S.L. 2024 (59 O.S. Supp. 2025, Section

475.3), which relates to the State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Surveyors; extending sunset date; updating statutory language; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SB 1771 – By Thompson of the Senate and Tedford of the House.

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Workforce Commission; amending Section 5, Chapter 361, O.S.L. 2023, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 408, O.S.L. 2025 (40 O.S. Supp. 2025, Section 904), which relates to the powers, duties, and responsibilities of the Commission; permitting the Commission to collect certain data; authorizing the Commission to employ outside counsel; and providing an effective date.

SB 2110 – By Murdock of the Senate and Newton of the House.

An Act relating to agriculture; amending 2 O.S. 2021, Section 10-78, which relates to the sale of eggs; allowing for sale of certain eggs in specified locations; establishing limit on sale of ungraded eggs; and providing an effective date.
